

## FOLLOW-UP EXERCISE “WHAT HAS STAYED?”

### REQUIRED MATERIALS

Printed or laminated photographs of various locations on today's grounds of the Dachau Memorial Site (at least as many as there are participants, but more to select from is most welcome). Images you can use for this exercise are to be found [here](#) (ZIP, 15 MB). The image rights are held by the Dachau Memorial Site.

### WORK FORM

Group seated on chairs in a circle

### TIME REQUIRED

30 to 45 minutes for the lesson unit following the visit to the Dachau Memorial Site

### GOAL

The participants reflect on the visit to the Dachau Memorial Site and aided by photographs articulate their thoughts and feelings.  
The respective motif of a photograph serves to initiate discussion.

### DESCRIPTION



The teacher places the photographs on the floor in the middle of the circle. The participants are asked to pick out a motif that they associate with their visit to the Dachau Memorial Site.

In the group the participants show their respective photo and explain why they decided on this motif and what they associate with it.

The teacher is to avoid commenting on the statements given by the participants, except if these are incorrect and contain false information.

This method is based on an exercise developed by the Max Mannheimer Study Center.
